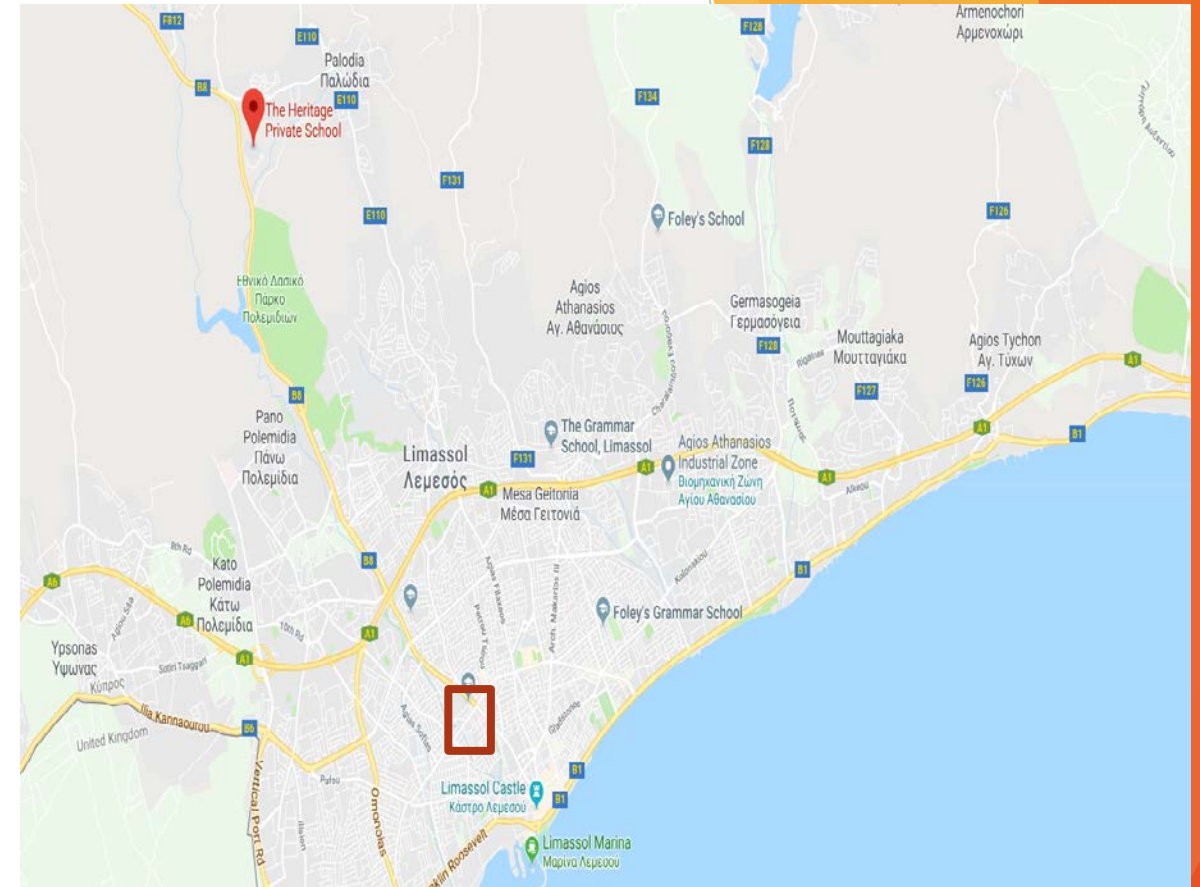


# The Heritage Private School

# A Brief History

- ▶ The Heritage Private School began in 1987 in Moni, a village near Limassol, with only six pupils.
- ▶ It then moved to Limassol in 1988. By then there were 22 students.
- ▶ Over time, the school expanded. By 1991, there were 207 students.
- ▶ In 2007, the school moved to its current location, 4.5 km north from Limassol town.
- ▶ Now, there are over 1200 students from 55 countries. We see interaction between different nations and cultures as vital in the modern world. Students at the **Heritage** are encouraged to respect each other's cultures and the Cypriot culture in which they are living.



# Aims & Ethos

The aims of our school are to develop better education and skills, and to help students to reach their full potential and achieve their goals, and become well-rounded, responsible, international citizens.



# ICT Facilities

# Education

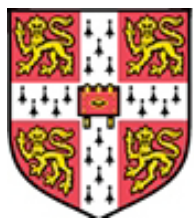
- ▶ The School is committed to a rigorous academic programme leading to University entrance.
- ▶ High standards of achievement, effort and examination success are strongly encouraged.
- ▶ The school follows the British curriculum.
- ▶ Curriculum at the school is carefully developed by taking into consideration our multi-cultural student body.
- ▶ The Heritage Private School is accredited by the British Council UK for “outstanding development of the international dimensions in the curriculum”
- ▶ In Year 11 students take their IGCSE exams, and in Years 12 and 13 their AS and A2 Level exams.
- ▶ Also, in Year 6 and Year 9 students pass Cambridge Checkpoint exams.
